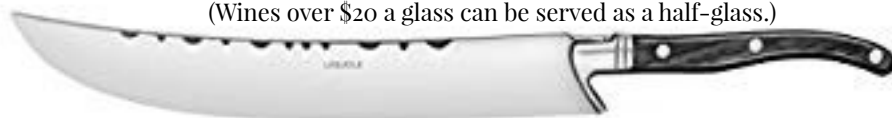

Disruption - Washington State - 35

The variety is unmistakable on this wine, with its aromas of black currant, black cherry, dried herb and spice. the palate is fruit filled but well structured, with tart acids and a firm squeeze of tannin. and dark chocolate.

Requiem - Columbia Valley - 49

A scientific and biodynamic approach to the ecological whole of the vineyard, where the quality of wine depends not only on the grapevines, but the interdependent relationship between the whole environment.

Juggernaut - Napa - 49

French oak beautifully transforms intense mountain fruit into a wine with uncommon richness, yet smooth and luxurious texture. Juggernaut Hillside Cabernet is a wine that is fierce, brave, and delicious.

Double Lariat by Jameson Ranch Vineyards - Napa - 63

Dark & creamy with enticing aromas that jump out of the glass. notes of black currant, anise, and cedar intrigue the senses. The one takeaway that we have after tasting, is that this Cabernet is incredibly smooth!

Chateau Buena Vista - Napa Valley - 73

Earthy-cherry aromas linger in this elegant, restrained red. Great acidity integrates with cranberry and sandalwood while red fruits abound. The finish sweetens the palate with a hint of maple but keeps things dry with violet petals. The luxurious mouthfeel can be attributed to 28 months of aging in French oak.

Priest Ranch by Somerston Family - St. Helena - 77

This intense wine has tons of blueberry, licorice and blackberry aromas. Full-bodied, rich with plenty of tannin tension. If you're looking for something that over delivers, this is it!

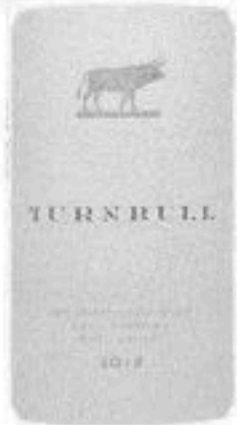

Venge "Silencieux" - Napa Valley - 130

Powerful and full bodied, opening with scents of sweet cassis, anise, blackberries, roasted coffee, and vanilla. The tannins are firm and upfront with a full mouth-coating lead into a concentrated and lengthy finish.

Tres Sabores "Perspective" - Rutherford - 150

an eight-barrel selection from the estate vineyard, you'll find dusty blackberry nose of considerable proportion that yields to dried plums & cassis. the flavors are bold and plush with a velvet interior - overall the impression is one of rounded elegance. this is a mind-blowing wine in every aspect.

Larkmead - Calistoga - 250

larkmead is one of the oldest, family-owned grape-growing estates in the napa valley. this historic site offers tremendous diversity in its soils, and possesses a rare character usually found at unique hillside sites. winemaker dan petroski captures nuance and complexity, in this legendary wine.

Tom Eddy - Napa Valley - 210

Classic mountain Cabernet Sauvignon from Napa Valley. Sourced from the winery's hillside vineyards, resulting in an elegant, seductive Cabernet with well integrated tannins, exhibiting flavors of chocolate, espresso bean and black cherry.

Larkmead - Calistoga - 250

Larkmead is one of the oldest, family-owned estates in the Napa Valley. This historic site offers tremendous diversity in its soils and possesses a rare character usually found at unique hillside sites. Winemaker Dan Petroski captures nuance and complexity in this legendary wine.

Cornell - Sonoma County - 280

This 642 case production wine comes from the Sonoma side of Spring Mountain. Organically farmed on some of the most diverse soils in the world, resulting in a complex expression of Cab. Another classic mountain Cab.

Realm Cellars "The Bard" - Stags Leap - 300

"This blessed plot, this earth, this realm..." Immortal lines from William Shakespeare's King Richard @, the source of the Realm's, this winery's name. Features grapes from the most prominent sites in Napa. Beckstoffer To Kalon and Dr. Crane, Blair Vineyard, Weitz Vineyard, Fortuna Vineyard and Beckstoffer Orchard have all found a place in The Bard. Mind blowing!



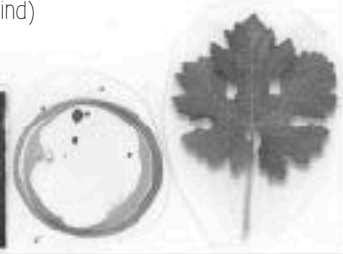

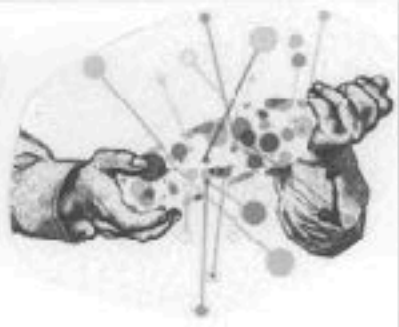

Ramey Claret - Napa Valley - 70

David Ramey's namesake winery is where the marriage of Old World methods with New World innovations thrive. This blend drinks beautifully with brambly wild berries and cocoa, incredibly balanced.

Pendulum - Columbia Valley - 42

Washington state is basically the Italy of America at this point. This gorgeous wine has developed fruit on the palate with strawberry, mocha, chocolate and a coffee bean undertone.



Vermillion - California - 85

The quality of wine is based on the quality of all its inputs - good vineyards, smart farming, pure and focused winemaking, attention and TLC at every step.

Hourglass HGIII - Napa Valley - 88

Tony Biagi, formerly of Plumpjack and Cade, joined Hourglass in 2012 and continues to make exceptional Napa Cabernet blends. Have a glass or two!



Scout's Honor - Napa Valley - 95


The Venge (ven-ghee) family has farmed vitis vinifera varieties in Napa Valley for nearly half a century. This Zinfandel dominant blend is amazing, enjoy with our half and half board.


Jonata Todos - Santa Ynez - 100

Defined by exuberant fruit, both red and black. Also shaped by familiar Jonata notes of smoked sausage, black pepper and black plum skin. Syrah sexiness combined with Cabernet focus and structure.

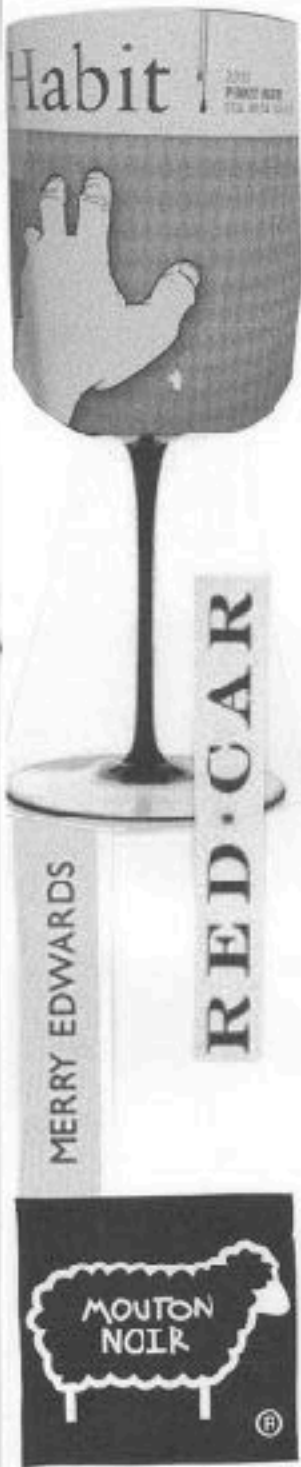

Foris - Rogue Valley - 35

One of the first wineries to plant the "dijon clone" in Oregon. Foris is home to the southern-most vineyard in the Pacific Northwest. Bright cranberry in hue, with a spicy, heady perfume of Bing cherries, red plums, floral nectar.

Avaraen - Willamette Valley - 46

Adam Smith, winemaker of Banshee's first vintage, creates an outstanding representation of Pinot Noir. Balanced, focused, full of ripe cherry, baking spice and cranberry.

Lichen "Moonglow" - Anderson Valley - 53

Delicate and poised, finishing with anise, spice and everything nice. The texture is sleek and refined. Caramel and vanilla bean accents a core of ripe tart cherry and raspberry flavors.

Anthill Farms - Anderson Valley - 63

Aromas of lifted plum, dried rose and forest floor. An alluring melange of cherry and herbal flavors fan out from the entry to the palate. Gracious and light on its feet.

Failla - Sonoma Coast - 70

Ehren Jordan's Pinot Noir is a benchmark for new world Pinot. A Pinot Noir that has it all, warm tones of baking spice, wild sage, balsam and classic cherry coulis with fine tannins.

Joleté - Willamette Valley - 70

Jim Sanders, the name behind the wine, places a lot of pride in the details. Think small production, hand-crafted and aged in top-tier French oak. You can't get better than that.

Hirsch Vineyards - San Andreas Fault - 125

The flagship wine from Hirsch, and the wine that represents the summation of their complex vineyard. Due to the site's proximity to the Pacific Ocean and the San Andreas Fault, the vineyard has a fearsome diversity of soils, aspects, elevations and microclimates.

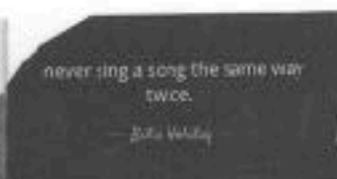
Larue - Rice - Spivak Vineyard - 140

Katy Wilson is a one woman operation, hell-bent on doing everything herself, you name it. Hauling grapes, punchdowns, to racking. Her deft hand creates a lasting impression of Pinot Noir. Fresh strawberry, cranberry and pomegranate flavors are elevated by bright acidity

Hartford "Old Vine" Zinfandel - Russian River Valley - 70

This amazingly delicious Zinfandel reflects the character and heritage of dry-farmed and low-low-yielding vineyards. The blend offers alluring aromas of boysenberry, raspberry and hints of white pepper.

Outpost - Howell Mountain - 90

Expresses a singular experience with clarity, depth and richness without exception. Dense but rich and fleshy, offering bold black currant, crushed pepper and toasty vanilla aromas

Brulliam - Rocky Ridge Vineyard, Rockpile - 110

That trademark Rockpile minerality keeps the wine focused and taut. This vineyard has it all, elevation, fog inversion, rocky soil. It's elegance shines with great acidity.

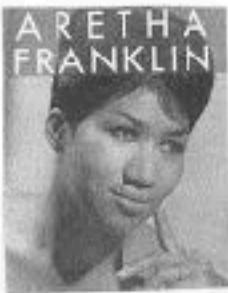

Saddleback - Oakville - 88

85% of the fruit was harvested on their estate vineyard in Oakville and 15% derives from Carneros. Saddleback Cellars was established in 1976 in the heart of the Napa Valley by Nils Venge. Nils is universally regarded as one of the foremost pioneers of the Napa Valley wine industry, garnering the first 100-point wine score on his 1985 vintage of Reserve Cabernet. A dark and juicy Merlot with flavors of blueberry and anise, this wine is aged for 18 months in French and American oak. Balanced tannins give this Cab-lovers Merlot a lengthy finish.

G.D.. Vajra Langhe Rosso - Piedmont - 42

a cool blend of nebbiolo, dolcetto, and darbera. translucent garnet color in the bowl yields to vibrant aromas of black currants, black tea, tobacco, and tar. brisk and lively in the mouth, the wine conveys a core of chewy cherry, loganberry, and cassis fruit before transitioning to a long finish.



Elio Perrone "Tasmorcan" Barbera - Piedmont - 42

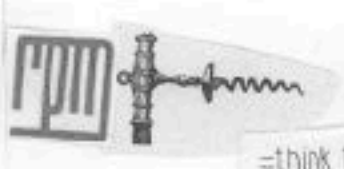

Dusi "J" Caterina's Syrah - 88

This warm climate Syrah from the Templeton Gap is juicy, with rich dark fruits on the palate. Cool nights and low yields result in pops of blackberry and blueberry that are balanced by limestone and leather.

Reeve Sangiovese - Windsor Oak Vineyard, Chalk Hill - 13

this is truly one of the most profound wines i have tasted. being a grape that is popular in italy - where you get all the dried cherries, tannin, and leather, it is so amazing to taste sangiovese grown in northern sonoma. you get all the personality of italy, mixed with the spicy fruit of cali. i absolutely love it. - paul killingsworth

Campuget - Costieres de Nimes - Rhone Valley - 28

This rosé of Syrah and Grenache has a nice appearance with a light and fresh pink color. Its color is obtained through a short maceration period between 4 and 12 hours. Features a particularly fruity taste of raspberries and strawberries with refreshing acidity.



The Pairing - Santa Rita Hills, Santa Barbara - 43

It takes beautiful juice to make beautiful rosé. This salmon colored edition is the result of Pinot Noir grapes harvested slightly earlier to focus on freshness and vibrancy. The juice is from 44 year old

Babich - New Zealand - 28

superb! lovely lime lift right through the center: herbal and grassy, more citrus. medium-bodied and ultra-mouth-watering. Laser-like refreshment and focus with a big hug of citrus zest. some gooseberry and lemon on the finish. fresh seafood anyone?

Rickshaw - California - 30


A nice blend of tropical fruit notes framed by a slight savory touch. It opens up with beautiful aromas of jasmine, white peach, passion fruit and a slight hint of fresh meadow. Flavors of candied lemon, orchard fruits, mint, sage and the slightest hint of guava.


Leth Grüner Veltliner - Austria - 35

Rich and lush, with ripe peach and buttery apple flavors, followed by a long, spicy and cream-filled finish. This wine drinks extremely similar to Sauvignon Blanc, if you're looking to try something different, check this Gru-V out.

Disruption - Washington - 35

from esteemed evergreen vineyard in the ancient lakes appellation. it charms with aromas of green apple, bosc pear and mineral. the flavors are medium bodied and pure, with a lightly creamy feel and a zing of acidity stitching it all together. (un-oaked)

Fable - California - 35

Aged in new (30%) and neutral French oak barrels for 12 months. Pastry crust and toasted almonds give way to lemon cream and chai on the nose. The palate is elegant with mouthwatering acidity and texture.

Tyler - Santa Barbara - 53

Blend of a number of vineyards in santa maria valley. the wine sees less than 10% new wood is left to rest on its lees for about a year before it is moved to tank for the last few months prior to bottling to ensure tension, elegance, and precision. (burgundy in style)

Kokomo - "Peter's Vineyard" Russian River Valley - 6

This is a spicy, flavorful and fairly straightforward vineyard-designate. it's not overly complex, but offers a mix of classic gravenstein-apple fruitiness with medium-bodied texture and weight. great balance of butter and oak! (california in style)

Peay - Sonoma Coast - 70

The mouth has a silky, slightly oily texture that is round yet precise and extraordinary. the finish emphasizes their estate chardonnay's mineral profile with excellent acidity and a medium to long finish. this is grand cru quality juice at a fraction of the price! (high-end burgundy in style)

Matteo Braidot Pinot Grigio - Friuli, Italy - 25 - pear aromas on the nose, gentle hints of citrus blossom. finishes dry with a refreshing mineral zip.

Incline Riesling by Selbach - Germany - 32 - clean with just a hint of residual sugar, this wine vividly represents all that mosel wine should be... fruity with vibrant acidity, clarity, and precision.

Chateau la Hargue Semi-Dry White Blend - Bordeaux, France 39 - Are you a sweet wine drinker looking to try something different than Moscato and Riesling? This is the wine for you.

Expression by Chateau Beaubois - Rhone, France - 30 grenache blanc: green apple and white stone; marsanne: structure and honeysuckle aromas; roussanne: herbal, tea-like notes; viognier: elegant floral perfume.

Clendenen Aligote - Santa Maria Valley - 53 - tastes of dry tropical fruit, baked apple, ripe pineapple. Try it with our Ahi Tuna for a perfect pairing.

Reeve "Prism" Riesling - Mendocino County 77 "We call this wine Prism because riesling has the power-when great-to display such an array of flavors and aromas that calls to mind the refraction of white light into Technicolor."

Sabartes Cava Brut Reserva - Penedes, Spain - 28 - Clean and not vinous, easy to drink, soft bubbles on the palate

Elio Perrone "Sourgal" Moscato - Piedmont, Italy - 42 - Yellow, changing towards green, vivid. It recalls orange flowers, yellow peach, sage and just picked Muscat grapes

Turbulent - Cote Ronnais, Loire, France - 53 - This sparkling rosé of Gamay has a rounded attack with a lively finish

Le Grand Courtage - France - 49 - A delicate balance of dryness and acidity lingers with flavors of Meyer lemon, honeydew and soft floral notes.

Caraccioli Brut Cuvee - Santa Lucia Highlands - 77 - If you're in the mood for bubbles, this is a must try. Incredibly balanced with aromas of lemon meringue

Billecart-Salmon Brut Reserve - Champagne, France - 88 - Balance and harmony combine together in this light and subtle Champagne.

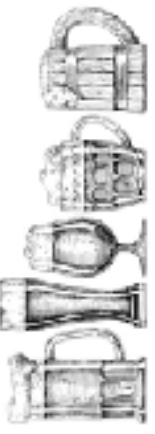
